- No delineation of scopes



- Sep. 20, 2019 Public comment period closes
- Oct. 3, 2019 Development Team meeting to review public comments and Instructional Guideline modifications (Washington, DC)
- Jan. 2020 Second draft released for public comment
- March 2020 Development Team meeting to review public comments and Instructional Guideline modifications (Dallas, TX)
- Summer 2020 New National EMS Education Standards published






In the future, how will the Scope of Practice Model, Education Standards and Instructional Guidelines be kept current?



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
